## Regulations, Codes & Standards Q&A: Temperature and ...

Q: How often are we required to log the room temperature, humidity levels, and air changes in our OR's? IS this required daily, each shift, hourly? What about the other rooms like Sterile Processing and others, how often do we need to log them?

## CDC

Whether the system runs continuously, is powered off during unoccupied periods, or is "set back" when empty, the indoor temperature and humidity conditions should always meet recommendations found in ANSI/ASHRAE 55-2013 and ANSI/ASHRAE 62.1-2013 any time the building is occupied.

## With OR humidity, follow CMS and risk assessment findings ...

Temperature, humidity, and airflow in the operating rooms must be maintained within acceptable standards to inhibit bacterial growth and prevent infection, and promote patient comfort. Excessive humidity in the operating room is conducive to bacterial growth and compromises the integrity of wrapped sterile instruments and supplies.

## Ventilation, Temperature and Humidity

The ASHRAE Standard 62, Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality, recommends a maximum RH of 70 percent for sterile storage areas. The maintenance staff has since installed a temperature/humidity meter and added the requirement for daily monitoring/recording by the OR staff.

## **New Guidance on Humidity Levels in the Operating Room**

A change in the standards regulating a hospital's physical environment in the operating room (OR) may conflict with the instructions for use on some equipment and supplies routinely used in surgery.
