A stepwise approach where women are identified as high risk in the first trimester and then reevaluated at the time of the mid-trimester anomaly scan is promising in terms of picking up most cases of early onset preeclampsia.<sup>45</sup> Combining first trimester uterine artery Doppler findings with maternal characteristics and serum markers in the manner of the first trimester fetal anomaly screening is likely to provide the best approach to first trimester screening for preeclampsia.
